Teachers Respect and Character Attributes Grant Easton Operation Respect Designated Fund

Instructions and Information

Purpose:

The Easton Learning Foundation (ELF), in conjunction with Easton Operation Respect, is making grants available to certified staff members in Easton Public Schools. The purpose of these grants is to provide opportunities for students to practice positive character attributes and to increase incidences of mutual respect. These grants should enhance the students learning experience, encourage superior instruction and augment the existing curriculum.

Eligibility:

Any certified staff member currently employed by the Easton School System may apply for a grant.

Criteria:

ELF will use the following general criteria when reviewing applications:

- Projects must provide opportunities for students to practice positive character attributes and to increase incidences of mutual respect.
- Students are engaged in a creative approach to learning that will add depth to curriculum and motivate students.
- Grants that benefit a larger target population are encouraged.
- Project must not be considered in the realm of the regular Board of Education budget.

Funding Guidelines:

- ELF will award grants not to exceed \$500.
- Grant requests may be partially or fully funded.
- The primary criterion for dispensing grants shall be high-quality educational content and the impact on students. Project should demonstrate sustainability, where applicable.
- ELF shall fund only those projects that do not supplant programs that are traditionally funded by the district, state or federal budgets.
- ELF gives preference to projects that will benefit the largest number of individuals.
- Grant funds may be used for but not limited to: educational materials and supplies, computer hardware and/or software, scientific or mathematical equipment, printing expenses, periodical or internet subscriptions, field trips, and other uses, provided they are part of innovative educational initiatives.
- ELF does not typically fund transportation costs, compensation for substitute teachers, or salaries or stipends for additional staffing as a result of the project.
- Grant approval based on merit and funds available.
- If for any reason the grant recipient is unable to administer the approved project, the recipient will return all the allocated funds to the foundation.
